

Documentation for Application for Admission into the Family House of the Evangelische Studierendengemeinde Bonn

The Dietrich-Bonhoeffer-Haus is a house for students in Bonn and the surrounding area. It is characterized by its ecumenical and international character and is sustained by the commitment and interest of its residents.

We want to meet the loneliness of solitary, everyday life in the university and offer an alternative: in our house students live with one another in tight-knit community, which requires mutual consideration, understanding, and tolerance, but also offers an active and shared life together. The taking on of responsibility is expected and the fulfillment of responsibilities (for instance, cleaning duty in one's own suite and participation in mentoring), as well as the participation in the full house meeting (twice per year) are indispensable. Non-compliance with these responsibilities can result in termination. If you are only seeking a cheap room in a nice location, without an interest in the life of the house, then our house is not a good fit for you.

In addition to the normal student house with 70 rooms, we also have a similar house for students with children at Poppelsdorfer Allee 77. Here there are six separate apartments of different sizes (2 to 4 rooms with kitchen and bathroom) and different rents (between 445€ and 725€, all utilities are covered including internet).

Decisions about admittance into the student house are made by the selection board which is comprised of members from office personnel, the congregation, and house residents. The portion of international student residents amounts to 30-40 percent. According to the model of ecumenism we are open to all applications, regardless of religious, confessional, political, and sexual orientation.

The rooms and offices of the Evangelischen Studierendengemeinde (ESG) are included in the buildings of the DBH. Residents of the student house are warmly invited to all functions and activities of the ESG.

Each year the application deadline for the Summer Semester is February 15 and for the Winter Semester is July 15.
